Clinical Research Fellow Practice Workshop

As part of the the Principles and Practice of Clinical Research course offered through Harvard Medical School, five to ten applicants from different countries will be invited to participate in a Clinical or Basic science research program at Harvard Medical School affiliated institutions.

The Clinical Research Fellow Practice Workshop has been created to enhance the interest in Clinical and Basic Science research by offering the opportunity to learn and practice research skills in Harvard Medical School affiliated basic and clinical science research laboratories.

The objective is to train future clinician investigators who will become leaders for international collaboration in medical clinical research and medical education.

- In addition, they will participate in the educational program from the department of continuing education, the six-month course in clinical research methodology (Principles and Practice of Clinical Research).
- Awardees will have the opportunity to work in a basic or clinical science research laboratory in Harvard Medical School affiliated institutions for a full year.
- The awardees will work on research projects and therefore have the opportunity to become co-authors in future publications.
